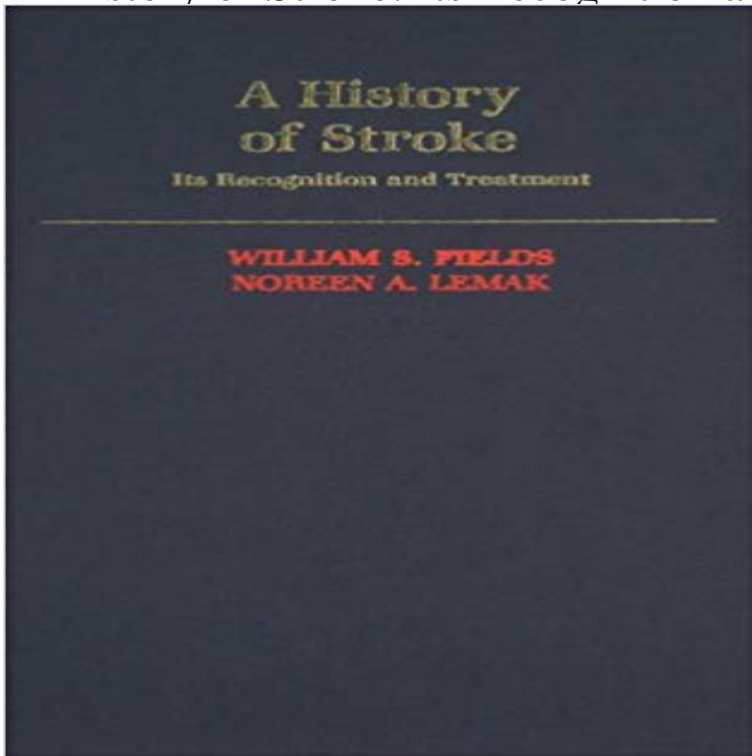


A History of Stroke: Its Recognition and Treatment
