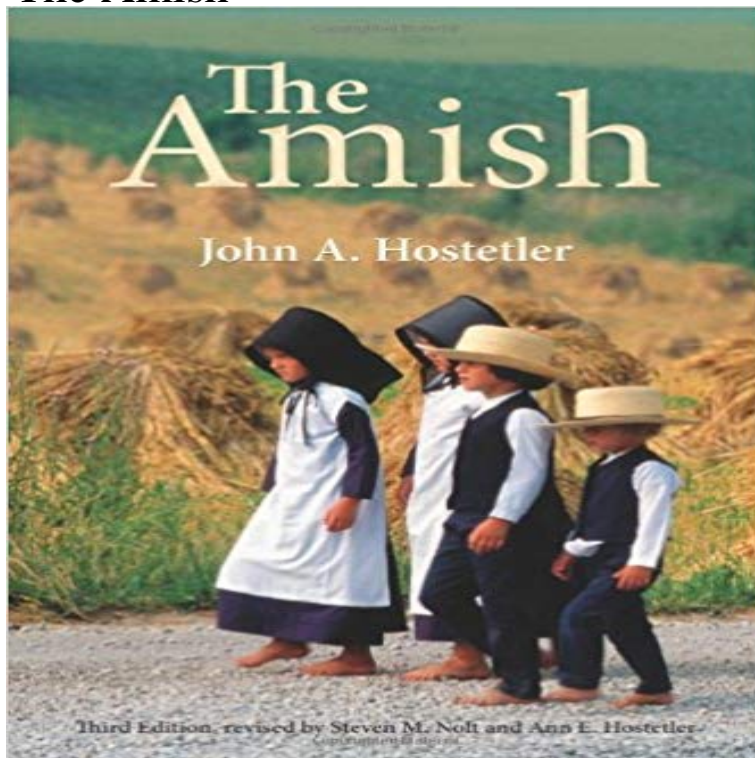


The Amish
