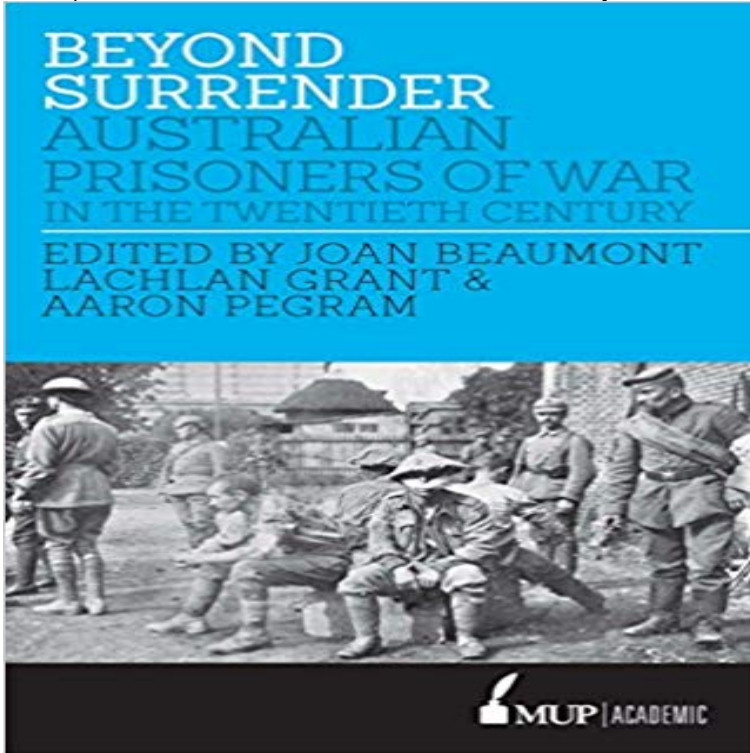


Beyond Surrender: Australian prisoners of war in the twentieth century
