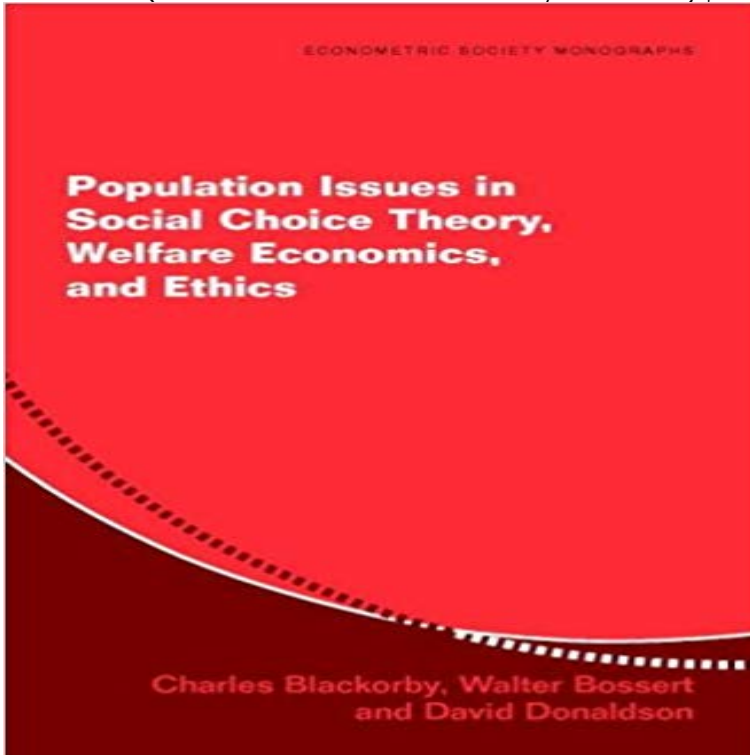


Population Issues in Social Choice Theory, Welfare Economics, and Ethics (Econometric Society Monographs)

Topics investigated include the measurement of individual well-being, social attitudes toward inequality of well-being, the main classes of population principles, principles that provide incomplete rankings or rank uncertain alternatives, best choices from feasible sets, and applications.
