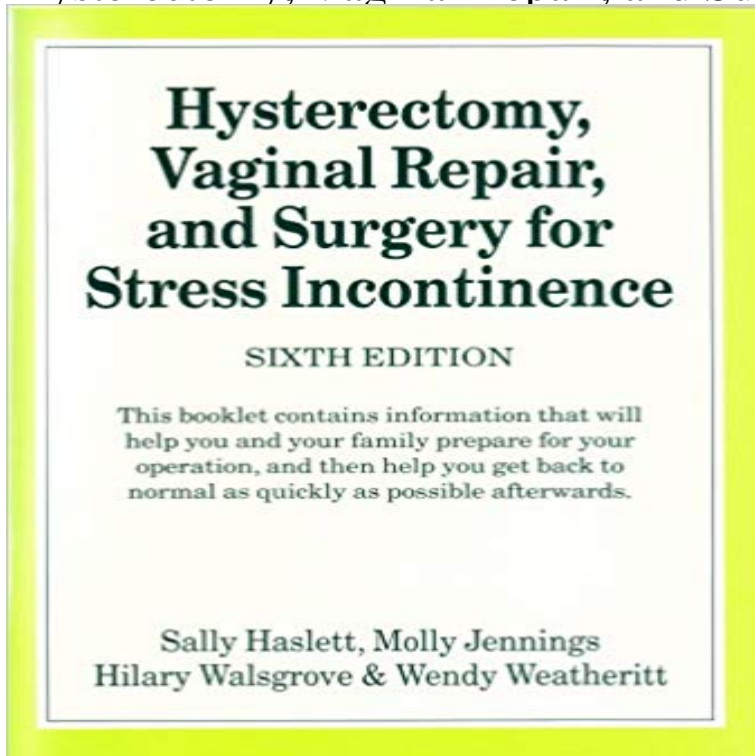


Hysterectomy, Vaginal Repair, and Surgery for Stress Incontinence



What is a hysterectomy, or a repair for prolapse, or an operation for stress incontinence? Will I put on weight or suffer from depression? Will I still have periods, or need contraception? How soon afterwards can I do housework, return to work or drive a car? Will my sex life be affected? What about lifting how soon and how heavy? When can I go swimming or do some gardening or start exercising again? If you have any one of these questions, this is the book for you. This booklet was originally developed by Sally Haslett and Molly Jennings as a result of working together at St Thomas Hospital, London with women who had undergone this type of gynaecological surgery. It was an instant success, and now for its Sixth edition they have been joined by two experienced co-authors, Hilary Walsgrove and Wendy Weatheritt, respectively a nurse practitioner and senior physiotherapist, both of whom specialise in women's health. The authors explain the meaning and effect of the operations and describe how to prepare in advance for them. They then give much useful advice on what to do afterwards, to enable you to gain a full and trouble-free return to normal life. Diagrams and photographs are included wherever these are likely to be helpful.
