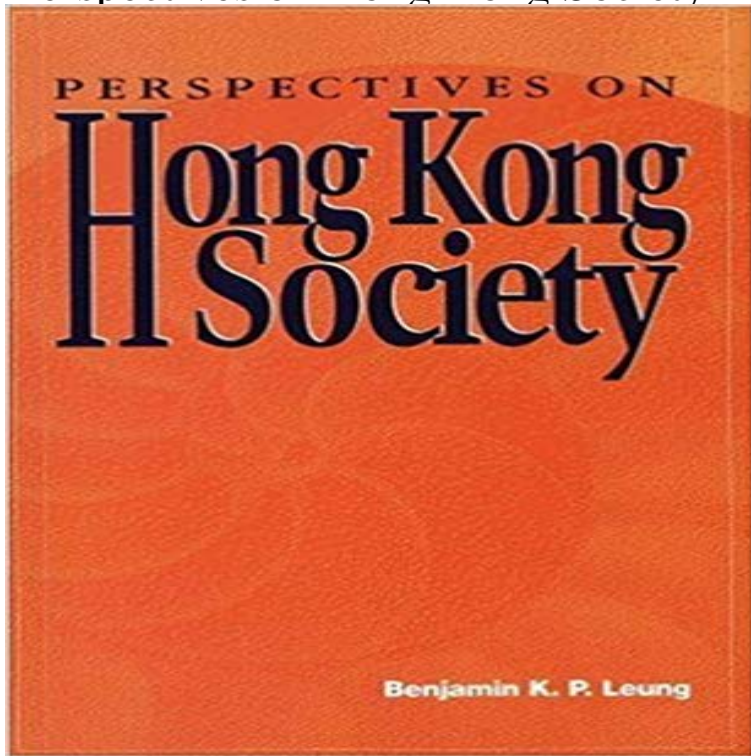


Perspectives on Hong Kong Society
