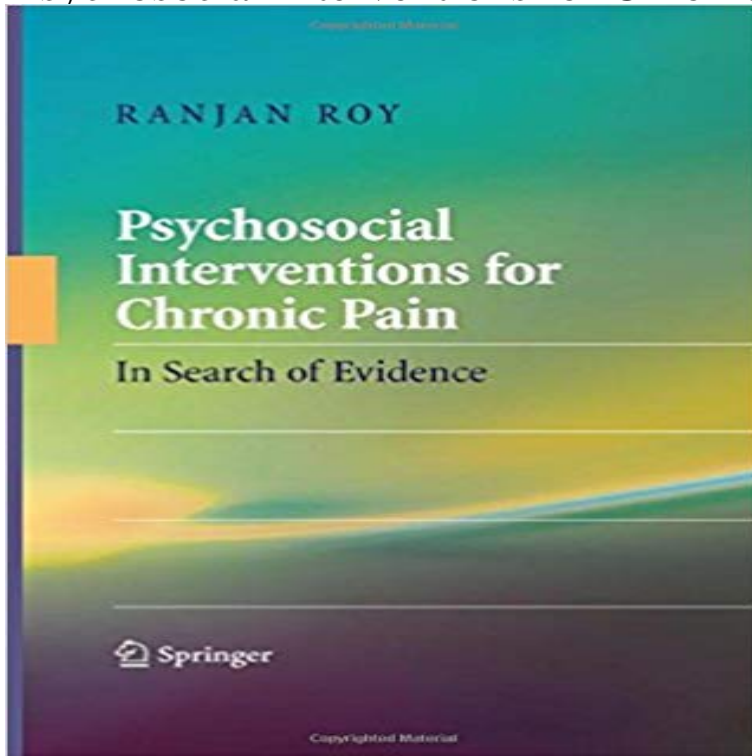


Psychosocial Interventions for Chronic Pain: In Search of Evidence
