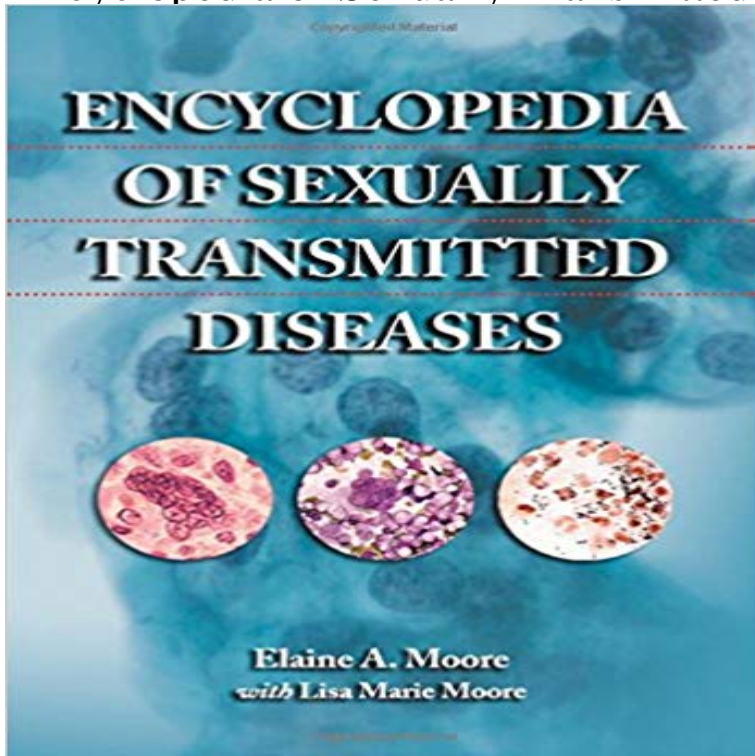


Encyclopedia of Sexually Transmitted Diseases
