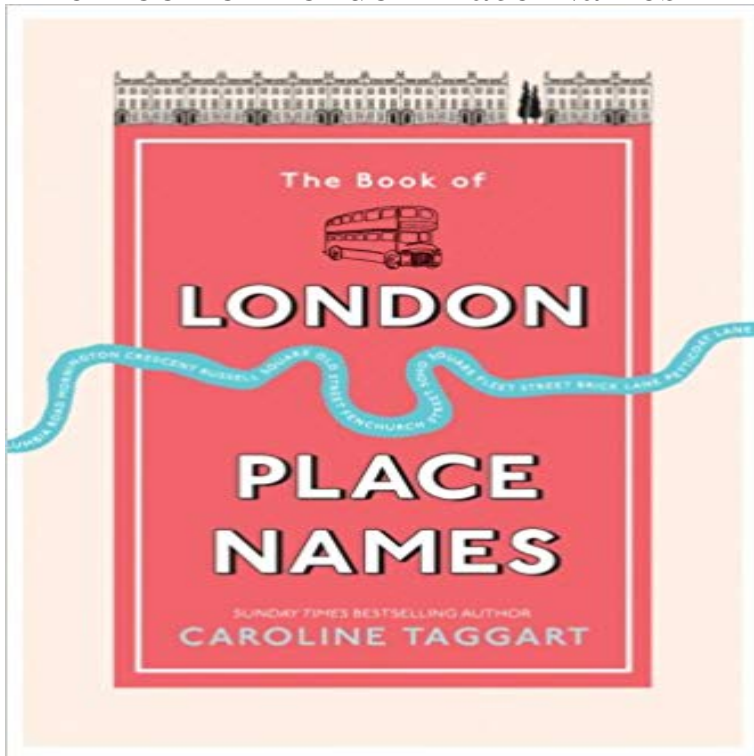


The Book of London Place Names
