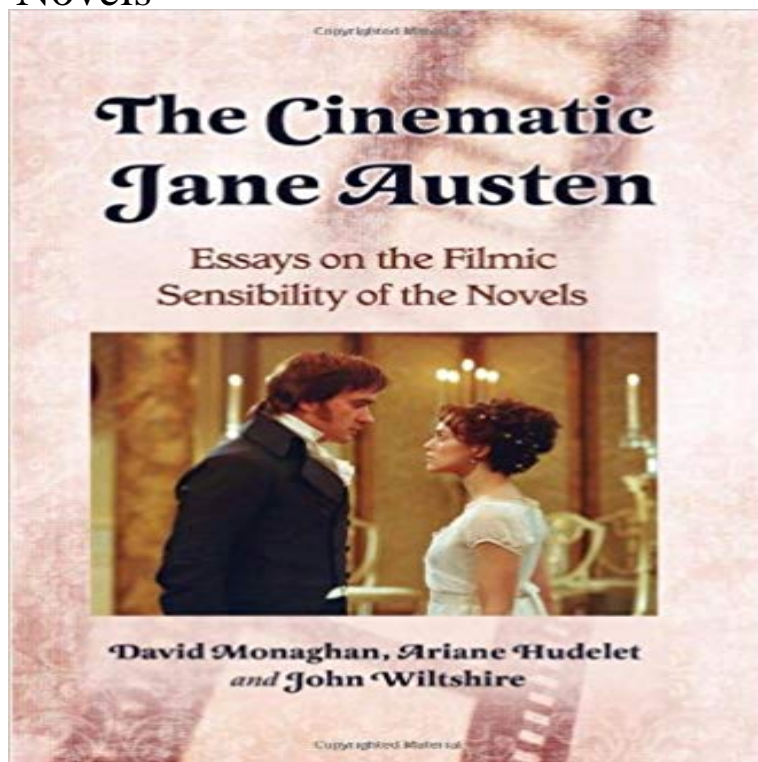


The Cinematic Jane Austen: Essays on the Filmic Sensibility of the Novels
