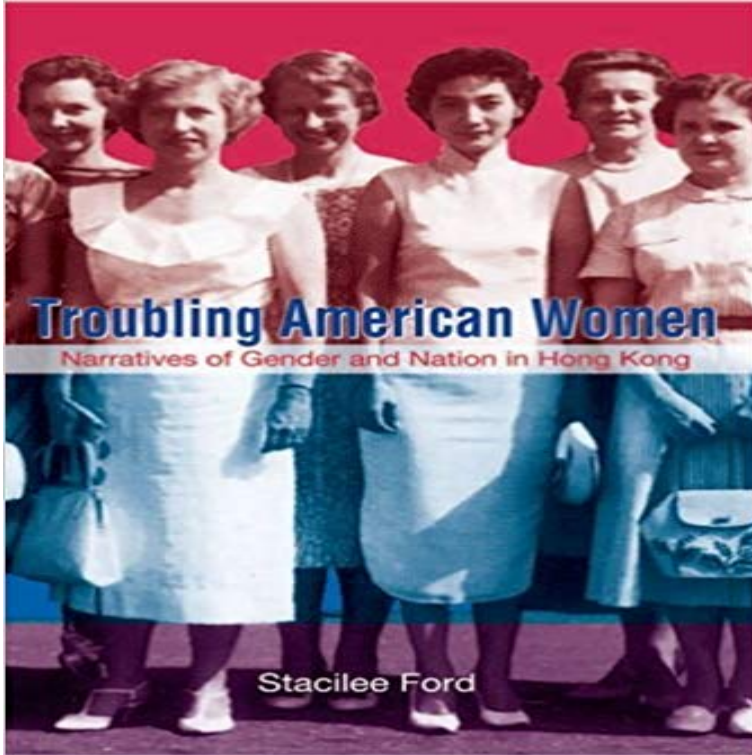


Troubling American Women: Narratives of Gender and Nation in Hong Kong
